COMMENTS: We own 720 acres of row crop land on Green River. This farm joins 231 and The Boy Camp and Indian Camp Creek.

The way this line is proposed it would go at an angle approx. 1 mile long across all crop land. From our estimate from 10 to 15 light poles

We own very large equipment. Our sprayer has 90 ft. boom, our Ambidex applicator is 52 ft. wide and we object to having light poles when there is an alternative to miss this farm.

In the past, ten years ago we spent \$180,000 tiling this farm. We spent ten dollars a foot laying mains in the bottom.

We built a levee against the creek side to protect this farm from flooding. Periodical when needed we hire airplanes to spray our crops. In the future G.P.S. systems will not function properly around this line. These poles would prevent the use of pivot irrigation system which we plan to install in the future.

The Eastern Power Co. that planned this is trying to go through crop land so they won't have to clear right away. We have Indian burial grounds on this farm. These poles would devalue this farm by \$200,000 to 250,000 dollars.
