ORDER

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission, on July 7, 2005, established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") of Berea College Electric Utility Department ("Berea") from November 1, 2004 through January 26, 2005, on which date ownership of the utility was transferred to the city of Berea. Subsequent to January 26, 2005, Berea is no longer subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

As part of this review, the Commission ordered Berea to submit certain information concerning its compliance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. Berea has complied with this Order. The Commission further ordered that a public hearing be held in this case but cancelled it when, after publication of notice, no interested party advised the Commission of its intention to attend.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds no evidence that Berea has improperly calculated or applied its FAC charge.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charges and credits applied by Berea through the FAC for the period November 1, 2004 through January 26, 2005 are approved.
