RE: Salt River Electric Cooperative Violations of Administrative Regulations

On September 27, 2005, an informal conference was held pursuant to the request of Salt River Electric Cooperative ("Salt River") filed with its September 20, 2005 response. Present at that meeting were those persons listed on the attached sign-in sheet.

The Commission issued a show cause Order to Salt River in response to an incident occurring on March 24, 2005, in which Billy Hamilton, a contractor's employee, was injured while reworking a 50-foot pole near Bardstown, Nelson County, Kentucky for Salt River. Mr. Hamilton suffered burns on his right forearm and on the two middle fingers of his left hand. Mr. Hamilton was not wearing rubber gloves or sleeves as required by the National Electrical Safety Code.

After a discussion of the procedure of the meeting; the representatives of Salt River presented their position as to the allegations contained in the show cause Order. Salt River admitted the facts as stated in the Incident Investigation Report filed with the show cause Order.

Salt River emphasized to the Staff the efforts that it uses to select its contractors. While Salt River has safety procedures and programs for its employees, it does not have a formal audit procedure for contractors and their employees. Salt River was of the opinion that since it requires the contractor to comply with all safety and regulatory requirements, it is the responsibility of the contractor to provide for the safety of its crew. It was the position of Salt River that it had done everything it could to provide for a safe work place and that the accident could only be attributable to a lack of employee concentration. Staff and Salt River discussed any other safety measure that could be taken such as documented safety audits for the contractors and consultation with LG&E about their employees' and contractors' safety training.

Staff and Salt River agreed, as a proposed settlement, that the two alleged violations would be merged and that Salt River would pay a civil penalty of \$2,500. Salt River also stated that it would seek to include in its contract negotiations a penalty provision for violation of safety regulations by the contractor. Salt River further stated it would contact LG&E about their contractors' safety training and audit program. Salt River agreed to formalize its audit procedure and to submit a written plan within 30 days. After all comments have been considered, Staff will prepare a settlement agreement for signature and recommend its acceptance by the Commission. If the settlement is not accepted by the Commission, Salt River and Staff will consider further procedures.

The meeting was adjourned.
