We, Glenn and Sue Shadoan, wish to intervene and make comments regarding Bluegrass Wireless LLC, Case Number 2005-00320, construction and operation of a new cell phone facility located at 449 Shackle Road, London, Kentucky.

We own property contiguous to the proposed construction site and our house is probably within 500 feet of the proposed tower. We request to intervene for the following reasons:

- (I) The tower construction is not needed;
- (2) Bluegrass Wireless LLC can co-locate onto another tower in a less populated area;
 - (3) We wish to avoid wasteful duplication of physical facilities;
- (4) The construction will have an adverse affect on our land use and will have an adverse effect on our property values;
- (5) The construction will create an air traffic danger as small planes and helicopters fly over our property on a regular basis;
- (6) The construction has already opened up our property line to off-road vehicles and our neighbors' horses which escape from their property. The entire property line must now be fenced to control access.
- (7) The construction will destroy the natural beauty and the aesthetic value of our wooded area. It will also create an eyesore for all of the surrounding neighbors;

- (8) The construction will create an encroachment on the wildlife habitat, specifically the barred owls, deer, fox, wildcat, and squirrels.

- (9) The construction may create an interference with our fifty (50) foot television tower, and may also interfere with our satellite reception.
- (10) We are also concerned about the health effects of the signal(s) transmitted to and from the cell phone tower.

We request a public hearing to have our concerns placed on the public record. We request the Public Service Commission to deny this application for any and all of the above reasons. We specifically have an interest in eliminating the wasteful duplication of physical facilities, and we request that Bluegrass Wireless be required to co-locate to a more suitable site in a less populated area.
