INTRA-AGENCY MEMORANDUM

Pursuant to the Commission Staff's notice dated October 6, 2005, an informal conference was held at the Commission's offices on that same date. A list of the attendees is attached hereto.

The conference was requested by Kentucky Power to discuss the Commission's September 30, 2005 rejection of the rate case application due to a deficiency under 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(a). Kentucky Power discussed the reasons why it believes it has substantially complied with the Commission regulations with regard to the customer notification. It further indicated that it was willing to provide a supplemental customer notification which would include certain limited information as required by Section 10(3)(a) and Section 10(3)(c), but will also be filing a formal request for a deviation to allow its rate application to be accepted for filing on the date originally tendered. Kentucky Power further indicated that, because it had to utilize weekly newspapers to publish customer notice, and that those newspapers required one week advance lead time, the earliest that a revised publication could be made would be October 19, 2005. Staff indicated that, based upon a renewed review of the rate application, it appeared that the filing contained three deficiencies: Section 10(3)(a); Section 10(3)(c); and Section 10(6)(e).

Kentucky Power indicated that it would take the Staff's suggestion under advisement in preparing its supplemental notice and deviation request. With that understanding, the conference was adjourned.
