On February 10, 2006, the Commission ordered that this conference call be conducted for the purpose of discussing possible settlement and the simplification of issues.

Beginning the conference, Mr. Wuetcher stated that Commission Staff would prepare minutes of the conference for the case record, that a copy of these minutes would be provided to all parties, and that all parties would be given an opportunity to submit written comments upon those minutes.

Mr. Wuetcher briefly discussed the procedure for the scheduled hearing. He then inquired about settlement discussions between the parties. Both parties indicated a willingness to engage in discussions. Mr. Prather listed the additional information that U.S. 60 Water District would need from Ms. Calvert to make any discussions more productive. Ms. Calvert stated that she would obtain this information. Both parties indicated that they would attempt to contact each other later in the week to discuss possible settlement. Mr. Wuetcher requested that the parties advise Commission Staff if a settlement were reached before March 27, 2006.

Mr. Wuetcher also advised the parties that the sole issue in this proceeding appeared to be whether a water utility could, as a condition for continuing water service to an existing customer, require the customer to provide an easement for facilities that are not necessary to provide or continue service to that customer. Issues related to the nature of the easement and the effect of the easement on the Complainant's property values are not germane to this proceeding.

The conference then adjourned.
