We are writing concerning the possible re-appointment of Arnie Puckett to the Ledbetter Water and Sewage Board. Mr. Puckett has satisfactorily served on the this Board since 1993 and would like very much to continue serving his community in this capacity.

However, recently when the position was due for re-appointment, Chris Lasher, Livingston County Judge Executive refused to appointment Mr. Puckett. Judge Lasher cited the fact that Mr. Puckett had missed several meetings while serving in the position. Arnie confirmed he had missed meetings due to medical reasons and family obligations; but also had perfect attendance several of the years during his service. He also acknowledged that, even when he was unable to attend meetings, he was always kept informed on matters concerning Board actions.
