I am writing to ask that the Public Service Commission consider rejecting the proposal from Louisville Gas and Electric Company to raise the rates of Natural-Gas to the extent they have requested.

As a consumer, I lowered my thermostat last Fall and Winter, saving one third in Gas consumption over the previous year. To my dismay, I still paid one third more for this reduced usage than the previous year.

When I read in the media that "L.G.&E will be making only "normal" profits and therefore the rate increase should be granted", my question is, why should the Public Service Commission guarantee L.G.&E "normal" profits (by permitting the rate increase) but insure a loss of discretionary income to all its customers? I would feel a bit more sympathetic if the L.G.&E proposal included a proposed REDUCTION of profit, not a loss you understand but something less than the present proposed status quo.
