ORDER

On January 31, 2002, in Case No. 2001-00092, the Commission approved rates for The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with ULH&P's gas cost adjustment ("GCA) clause.'

On October 10, 2005, ULH&P filed its GCA to be effective October 28, 2005. ULH&P previously obtained Commission approval to file its GCA within 20 days of the proposed effective date.²

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. ULH&P's notice includes rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.

2. ULH&P's Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") is \$13.010 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$1.4190 per Mcf from the previous EGC of \$11.591.

3. ULH&P's notice sets out no current refund adjustment ("RA"). The total RA of (.6) cent per Mcf represents no change from the previous total RA.

4. ULH&P's notice sets out no current quarter actual adjustment ("AA"). The total AA of (3.3) cents per Mcf represents no change from the previous total AA.

5. ULH&P's notice sets out no current quarter balancing adjustment ("BA"). The total BA of 4.5 cents per Mcf represents no change from the previous total BA.

6. ULH&P's gas cost recovery rate ("GCR") is \$13.016 per Mcf, which is \$1.4190 per Mcf more than its previous GCR of \$11.597.

7. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for final meter readings by ULH&P on and after October 30, 2005. ULH&P did not provide sufficient notice for rates to be effective October 28, 2005.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter readings on and after October 30, 2005.

2. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, ULH&P shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
