

Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3 proposes to make the following revision to its schedule of charges. The proposed effective date for the charge is 1 January 2006.

Non-Recurring Charges:

Effective 1 January 2006 a reconnect fee of \$25.00 will be charged to existing customers' whos service has been voluntarily turned off or service terminated for non-payment. The district will restore service as soon as possible, within 24 hours of payment. Customers requesting service be restored other then during normal working hours (7:30am-4:00pm Monday thru Friday) will pay an additional \$20.00 fee (\$45.00).

The fees contained in this notice are the fees proposed by the Muhlenberg County Water District No. 3. However, the Public Service Commission may order fees to be charged that differ from this proposed fee. Such action may result in fees for consumers other than the fee in this notice.

Any corporation, association, body politic, or person may, by motion within thirty (30) days after publication of this fee change, request leave to intervene; and the motion shall be submitted to the Public Service Commission, PO Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

Intervenors may obtain copies of the application and related filings at no cost by contacting the water district.

Muhlenberg County Water district No.3 has available for inspection at its office the proposed change to its Rules and Regulations. The office is located at 4789 Main Street, Bremen, KY 42325.
