The Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of three regional meetings: the Green River Regional Meeting, held April 21, 2005 at the McCoy & McCoy Laboratories in Madisonville, Kentucky; the Northeast Regional Meeting, held April 19, 2005 at the Ponderosa Steakhouse in Morehead, Kentucky; and the Western Regional Meeting, held April 28, 2005 at the Ponderosa Steakhouse in Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties." The meetings for which approval is sought include instruction regarding tank maintenance and sampling and monitoring. Having reviewed KRWA's application describing the courses, the Commission finds that the courses will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be approved for 2.0 credit hours of water district management training per each meeting.
