Dear Public Service Commission,

The Commission has requested a response to the staff memorandum summarizing the informal conference of January 31, 2006 regarding the complaint of Jeffrey Charles Quarles. Due to the proximity of Kentucky American Water's facilities, Kentucky American Water was made a party to this case to assist the Commission in developing facts to adjudicate Complainant's complaint.

As a result of informal conference, representatives of Kentucky American Water and Peaks Mill Water District have met and have had a number of discussions regarding the Complainant's possible connection to either of their respective facilities. Kentucky American Water acknowledges that Peaks Mill has participated in these discussions without waiving any of its assertions in its Motion to Dismiss in the case.


Both Peaks Mill and Kentucky American Water have studied various options to determine whether and how a connection may be made as requested in the Complainant's action. The option of moving the master meter from Kentucky American's point of termination to the Franklin/Owen County line was one option raised in the informal conference. Depending on a number of factors, this could have an approximate cost of \$2500 to \$3500. Further, the transfer, if any, of the 700 feet of Peaks Mill water line inside Owen County to Kentucky American Water would be accomplished by either a sale or a contribution to Kentucky American Water. We understand that Peaks Mill is researching the depreciated cost of this asset.


