Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

In the May 26, 2006 order approving the Joint Application of Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (the "Companies") for the Construction of Transmission Facilities in Jefferson, Bullitt, Meade and Hardin Counties in Case No 2005-00467, the Public Service Commission ("Commission") granted the Companies the authority to work with landowners to make minor modifications in the route of the approved transmission line. Specifically, the Companies were permitted to move the approved centerline up to 500 feet in either direction as long as: (1) the move does not shift the line or its right-of-way onto the property of a different landowner, and (2) the property owner who is subject to the move agrees in writing to the change. The Companies were directed to file a survey of the final location of the line, before construction begins, if any changes were made in accordance with that Order.

The Companies have now finalized the location of the approved transmission line after working with a number of landowners, and changes have been made in seven locations as shown on the maps attached hereto. The centerline as approved by the Commission, designated route "AJU," is depicted on these maps in yellow, with the line to be built depicted in black. Changes to the route in the seven (7) locations can be seen by black line. Each of these changes is within the 500 feet permitted by the Commission and has been agreed to in writing by the affected landowner, and none of the changes move the line or its right-of-way onto the property of a different landowner. Construction of the line is set to begin no later than May 21, 2007.
