MOTION FOR INFORMAL CONFERENCE

Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (collectively "the Companies") move the Public Service Commission of Kentucky ("Commission") for an order establishing an informal conference for the purpose of discussing how the Companies can facilitate the Commission's consideration of their application in this proceeding should the Commission grant their request to exit the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. ("MISO") in the pending investigation. In its December 22, 2005 Order, the Commission found that the Companies' application in this case should be held in abeyance pending the final outcome in Case No. 2003-00266, but indicated that if the Commission granted the Companies' request in that proceeding the Commission would then move expeditiously to review the application presented in this case. The Companies have requested an order from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") as early as mid-February. If FERC grants the Companies' requested relief to exit MISO, time will be of the essence if the Companies are to transfer control of their transmission system to a new Reliability Coordinator and Independent Transmission Operator before the summer peak months. An informal conference will allow the potential parties to the proceeding to discuss how the Commission could review the application

in this case on an expedited basis to meet the desired deadline of transferring control to the proposed new Reliability Coordinator and Independent Transmission Operator by May 1, 2006 consistent with sound reliability procedures.

WHEREFORE, for these reasons, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company respectfully request the Commission schedule an informal conference at the Commission's offices during the week of January 23, 2006.
