ORDER

On January 25, 2006, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company ("Applicants") made an electronic filing giving notice that they believe the Commission should change the current procedural schedule applicable to these cases. The filing indicates that Applicants failed to give notice to all landowners who may be affected by one or both of the two lines that are the subject of these cases, and that they intend to file a revision to the applications in the near future.

The Commission issued an initial procedural schedule in these cases by Order dated January 6, 2006 that included the date of February 1, 2006 for a local public hearing in Elizabethtown. As the Applicants now state that the notice of the original

applications was insufficient, the Commission finds that holding a local public hearing on February 1, 2006 would be premature. Once the revised applications are filed, the Commission will issue a new procedural schedule that will provide additional time for motions to intervene and will reschedule the hearings in these cases. The Commission has already received numerous requests for a local hearing, so additional requests are not necessary. By subsequent Order, the Commission will schedule a new hearing in Elizabethtown.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the local public hearing previously scheduled for February 1, 2006 is postponed and shall be rescheduled by subsequent Order.
