SUPPLEMENT OF NEXUS COMMUNICATIONS, INC. TO ITS RESPONSES TO COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST DATA REQUEST

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Nexus Communications, Inc. ("Nexus"), by counsel, provides the following supplement to its Responses to the Commission Staff's First Data Request as follows:

* * * * *

In Data Request No. 3, Commission Staff requested that Nexus provide information concerning steps that have been taken to secure contracts to enable Nexus to continue to serve its customers "after March 11, 2006 when switching will no longer be required to be provided to Nexus by ILECs." Nexus responded by stating, among other things, that it was currently in negotiations with BellSouth Telecommunications Inc. ("BellSouth") to obtain a commercial agreement that will enable Nexus to continue serving customers by means of unbundled network elements ("UNEs"). Nexus now updates its response by stating that such commercial agreement has now been executed. The agreement's provisions regarding Nexus's continuing ability to lease UNEs from BellSouth do not differ in any relevant particular from the provisions in the current interconnection agreement between BellSouth and Nexus, and Nexus customers receiving

service by means of UNEs will continue to receive such facilities-based service without interruption.
