This letter is in response to Commission Staff's request, by telephonic conference held at ten a.m. on this date with attorneys for Bluegrass Telephone Company $\mathrm{d} / \mathrm{b} / \mathrm{a}$ Kentucky Telephone ("KTC") and Kentucky ALLTEL, Inc. ("ALLTEL"), respectively, that KTC clarify that its Emergency Motion for Order to Prevent Unlawful Interference with Service ("Motion") constitutes a petition before the Commission. The relief sought by KTC is that the Commission issue its Order enforcing KRS 278.520 and the interconnection agreement between KTC and Kentucky Alltel, Inc. ("Alltel"). Additional issues exist between the parties which may be amenable to resolution without Commission involvement.

Pursuant to the telephonic conference held today, ALLTEL agreed to place into the record written assurance that, pending Commission resolution of this matter, ALLTEL will take no action to block KTC customer calls as described in KTC's Motion. In addition, the undersigned attorney for KTC agreed to state, for the record, that she is unaware of any current blockage of KTC customer calls.
