Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission, on December 27, 2005, established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") of Fleming-Mason Energy Cooperative ("Fleming-Mason") for the 6 months ended October 31, 2005.

As part of this review, the Commission ordered Fleming-Mason to submit certain information concerning its compliance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056.
