ORDER

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission, on December 27, 2005, established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") of Fleming-Mason Energy Cooperative ("Fleming-Mason") for the 6 months ended October 31, 2005.

As part of this review, the Commission ordered Fleming-Mason to submit certain information concerning its compliance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. Fleming-Mason has complied with this Order. The Commission further ordered that a public hearing be held in this case but cancelled it when, after publication of notice, no interested party advised the Commission of its intention to attend.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds no evidence that Fleming-Mason has improperly calculated or applied its FAC charge.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charges and credits applied by Fleming-Mason through the FAC for the period May 1, 2005 through October 31, 2005 are approved.
