ORDER

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission, on December 27, 2005, established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") of Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Nolin") for the 6 months ended October 31, 2005.

As part of this review, the Commission ordered Nolin to submit certain information concerning its compliance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. Nolin has complied with this Order. The Commission further ordered that a public hearing be held in this case but cancelled it when, after publication of notice, no interested party advised the Commission of its intention to attend.
