The Public Service Commission has received the Confidentiality Petition you filed on May 19, 2009 on behalf of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Kentucky to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential under Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.870, *et seq*. The information is identified as pertaining to the current calculation of damages owed by SouthEast Telephone, Inc.

The Commission has reviewed the information and has determined that it is entitled to the protection requested on the grounds relied upon in the Petition. The Commission also notes that the financial information contained in the current Petition is substantively similar to financial information provided in a previous Petition by AT&T Kentucky in November 2007.
