### **APPLICATION**

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), pursuant to KRS 278.018(6) and 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8, hereby applies for approval of changes in certified service territory as agreed with Clark Energy Cooperative, Inc. ("Clark").

- 1. <u>Address</u>: The Applicant's full name and post office address is Kentucky Utilities Company, One Quality Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40507.
- 2. <u>Articles of Incorporation</u>: A certified copy of Kentucky Utilities Company's Restated Articles of Incorporation is on file with the Commission in Case No. 2005-00471.
- 3. <u>Statement of Business</u>: KU is a public utility engaged in the business of generating, transmitting, and distributing electric service.
- 4. <u>Description of Changes in Service Territory</u>: KU and Clark have individually agreed to the requested territorial change.

The territorial boundary change requested for the Charles E. Taulbee property in Clark County Kentucky is a re-alignment with property lines. This requested change will serve the purposes of KRS 278.016 by promoting the orderly development of retail electric service and by minimizing disputes between retail electric suppliers. The territorial maps provided constitute the entire agreement between KU and Clark.

Included is a summary list of the requested territorial changes identifying KU personnel familiar with the specifics of the facilities available, the reason for the change, and purposes served under KRS 278.016.

5. <u>Agreement and Maps</u>: Attached as Application Exhibit 1 of this filing are copies of the territorial map, detail map, and agreement signed by both parties for the property involved.

WHEREFORE, KU hereby requests, pursuant to KRS 278.018, that the Commission enter its order approving the service territory changes and Agreements allocating these electric consumers as agreed to by the parties. Due to the bulk of the maps, KU requests the Commission to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8 (2) and permit KU to file only two complete sets of maps.
