**MOTION OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY AND  
LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY TO  
SCHEDULE AN INFORMAL CONFERENCE**

Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) move the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to establish a procedural schedule in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this Motion, LG&E and KU state as follows:

On January 4, 2006, LG&E and KU filed revised tariffs to reflect proposed changes to their Customer Responsibilities and Discontinuance of Service sections of their tariffs. Although the Commission approved the existing tariff language in its Order of January 30, 2002, in *In the Matter of: Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company Tariff Filings Authorizing Certain Transfers of Unpaid Balances of Final Bills*, Case No. 2001-00248, during the course of the informal conference held on March 18, 2005, the Commission staff noted some concern that the wording contained in Section G of Original Sheet No. 90 of the Companies'

tariffs could be considered inconsistent with Commission regulation, 807 KAR 5:006, Section 14(1)(f).

As a result, the proposed tariff revisions filed in this proceeding were made in response to the Commission's Intra-Agency Memorandum dated May 17, 2005, and to remove the potential inconsistency and further elaborate on the Companies' policies in this area in an effort to avoid future misunderstandings between the Companies and their customers, this Commission or the Office of the Attorney General.

In order to implement these tariff revisions, the Companies' information technology system will require certain changes. Consequently, LG&E and KU ask the Commission to schedule an informal conference to facilitate the resolution of this proceeding and to allow the Companies to discuss implementation of the corresponding technological changes.

**WHEREFORE**, Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company move the Commission to enter an order scheduling an informal conference during the week of August 21, 2006.


