Re: Application for wireless telecommunications facility at 2 Manning Road, Stanton, Kentucky.

Dear Sir or Madam:

I have been retained by the Gannell Sue Smith Trust in connection with an application by Nextel WIP Lease Corp. (the applicant) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to erect a wireless communications tower at 2 Manning Road, Stanton, Kentucky. My client owns real property adjacent to the proposed facility. My client is opposed to the placement of a tower at the proposed location unless the following conditions can be met:

1. The applicant must provide my client and the Commission a detailed map of the precise location of the proposed tower. The map which accompanied the notification letter sent by the applicant's attorney incorrectly marked the roads in the area and therefore made it difficult to discern where this tower is to be placed.
2. The roads leading to and from the proposed tower must be restored to their original condition after the tower is erected.
3. The tower must contain all necessary aviation markers/lights as required by federal law.
4. The applicant must reimburse my client's attorney's fees incurred in connection with the proposed tower. Obviously, such amount will be directly related to the willingness of the applicant to comply with the above conditions.
