<u>ORDER</u>

On December 22, 2005, in Case No. 2005-00042,¹ the Commission approved rates for The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with ULH&P's gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On January 12, 2006, ULH&P filed its GCA to be effective February 1, 2006. ULH&P previously obtained Commission approval to file its GCA within 20 days of the proposed effective date.²

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. ULH&P's notice includes rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
- 2. ULH&P's Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") is \$10.308 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$1.827 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$12.135.

3. ULH&P's notice sets out no current refund adjustment ("RA"). ULH&P's notice sets out a total RA of (.6) cent per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total RA.

4. ULH&P's notice sets out no current quarter actual adjustment ("AA"). ULH&P's notice sets out a total AA of (.1) cent per Mcf which is no change from its previous total AA.

5. ULH&P's notice sets out no current quarter balancing adjustment ("BA"). ULH&P's notice sets out a total BA of 3.5 cents per Mcf which is no change from its previous total BA.

6. ULH&P's gas cost recovery rate ("GCR") is \$10.336 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$1.827 per Mcf from its previous GCR of \$12.163.

7. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for final meter readings by ULH&P on and after February 1, 2006.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter readings on and after February 1, 2006.

2. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, ULH&P shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
