ATTORNEY GENERAL'S WRITTEN COMMENTS FOR COMMISSION STAFF REPORT

The Attorney General, in response to the Commission's 1 March 2007 Order, notes that he does not intend to call any witnesses during the hearing scheduled for 15 March 2007. The Attorney General states that his issues of contention are the reasonable recoverable costs relating to the lift station and whether this proceeding should include any additional consideration for the projects appearing on Attachment C of the Commission Staff Report. The Attorney General reserves the right to reply to any issue raised by the Applicant.

The Attorney General has reviewed the Commission Staff Report, and he notes the following: The Staff indicates that it does not yet have sufficient information to determine the reasonableness of the cost of the lift station. In any event, the Attorney General continues to assert that the recoverable costs for the

General agrees with Staff's recommendation that such project costs be recovered through general rates. Additionally, there should be no recovery through rates for repairs (and corresponding costs such as depreciation) to the lift station performed after the point in time when it should have already been replaced through the exercise of reasonable diligence.

WHEREFORE, the Attorney General submits his Response with Written Comments.
