O R D E R


On February 17, 2006, the Commission entered an Order in this case finding that AT&T Communications of the South Central States, LLC ("AT&T") had filed a notice of satisfaction which appeared to satisfy Complainant's January 25, 2006 formal complaint. In that Order, the Commission allowed the Complainant 20 days from the date of the Order to file a response to AT&T's notice of satisfaction. The Commission also ordered that the case would be closed and removed from the Commission's docket if no response was received from Complainant. The time for filing a response to the notice of satisfaction expired on March 9, 2006 and, as of the date of this Order, no response has been filed. Pursuant to its February 17, 2006 Order, and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(5), the Commission finds that this case should be dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is dismissed with prejudice and is removed from the Commission's docket.
