The purpose of this memo is to advise each of the wholesale customers purchasing treated water from Mt. Sterling Water & Sewer System that there will be a rate increase effective October 1, 2005. The new wholesale rate will be:

\$1.88 per thousand gallons

Please note that this is a flat rate. Your current rate has averaged \$1.73 per thousand gallons. The increase will average about 8%. The last increase was in 1998. The increase is necessitated by the fact that our operating expenses through the last four years have increased over 30% with revenues increasing less than 8%.
