Attention All Employees:

All conductors must be worked as ENERGIZED if they are not grounded. Never assume a conductor is de-energized for any reason unless it is first checked for voltage and grounded. In no case may an employee approach within 2 feet of an energized conductor without proper safety Equipment and Rubber gloves. Always make a second inspection that the proper switches have been open to de-energize the proper circuit. All lines must be grounded if you are not working them as energized.

Safety Rule Violation Penalties

The Safety rule violation penalties in your handbook range from Verbal reprimand on first offense to dismissal on a third offense. Due to the seriousness of the offense, any employee working on a de-energized line that has not been tested for voltage and grounded without rubber gloves will be dismissed on the first offense. If the line is not grounded then you must wear your rubber gloves.
