The Commission's Order of November 13, 2006, requires the parties to provide today to the Commission a status report of their negotiations, including a date certain for filing their negotiated agreement. The parties hereby advise that two of the seven issues identified in the arbitration petition have been resolved this week. Those are Issues 3 and 4, relating to line conditioning and the Transit Intermediary Charge.

Dialog and BellSouth are continuing negotiations regarding five unresolved issues. However, if by December 15, 2006, such issues are not resolved, the parties will so advise the Commission so that a hearing date may be established.

BellSouth's counsel has authorized the undersigned to sign this letter on her behalf.
