ORDER

On March 3, 2006, Dialog Telecommunications, Inc. ("Dialog") filed a petition for arbitration with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"). Dialog enumerated 7 issues unique to this proceeding for which it sought arbitration.

The Commission issued a full procedural schedule, including prefiled testimony and a public hearing. The parties filed their testimony but then requested that the hearing be postponed to enable them to negotiate. After several months, the parties have resolved all but one issue. By letter dated January 22, 2007, which was signed by both parties, the Commission has been notified that the only remaining issue is Issue 5 regarding the change of law and its effect on the parties' contract. The parties have agreed to incorporate into their interconnection agreement the applicable rulings by the Commission in Case No. 2004-00427.¹

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. This matter is removed from the Commission's active docket, as all issues unique to this proceeding have been resolved.

2. Dialog and BellSouth shall file their interconnection agreement with the Commission within 60 days after the issuance of the final Order in the change of law docket.
