ORDER

On March 3, 2006, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") filed proposed changes to the Demand-Side Management Balance Adjustment ("DBA") component of its Demand-Side Management Cost Recovery ("DSMCR") tariff. The changes are based on KU's over- or under-recovery of demand-side management program costs incurred in calendar year 2005. The proposed tariff includes an effective date of April 3, 2006. The revised DBA components, with the proposed changes, will remain in effect for 12 months.

KU's proposed revisions result in increased DBA charges to customers served under Residential Rate RS, Volunteer Fire Department Service Rate VFD, Large Power Rate LP, and Small Time-of-Day Service Rate STOD. KU's proposed revisions result in reduced DBA charges for customers served under General Service Rate GS.

Based on a review of the revised tariff and the supporting calculations of KU's over- and under-recoveries of DSM costs in 2005, the Commission finds that KU's proposed tariff changes are reasonable and should be approved effective April 3, 2006.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. KU's proposed changes to its DSMCR tariff are approved effective April 3, 2006.
- 2. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, KU shall file its revised DSMCR tariff that shows the date issued and that it was issued by authority of this Order.
