ORDER

On March 9, 2006, Garrard County Water Association ("Garrard County") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.012; and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- Garrard County purchases water from the city of Lancaster ("Lancaster"),
 the city of Danville ("Danville"), and the city of Berea ("Berea").
- Lancaster notified Garrard County that, effective April 1, 2006, Lancaster's wholesale water rate to Garrard County would increase from \$1.70 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.78 per 1,000 gallons.
- 3. During the 12 months ending January 31, 2006, Garrard County purchased 244,091,540 gallons from Lancaster, 88,849,761 gallons from Danville and 26,512,860 from Berea and sold 293,581,310. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$19,527, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.07 per 1,000 gallons.
- 4. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.07 per 1,000 gallons is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Garrard County's proposed rates are approved.
- 2. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.07 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved for water service rendered on and after April 1, 2006.
- 3. The proposed tariff sheets contained in Garrard County's application are accepted as filed.
