Beginning the conference, Commission Staff stated that it would prepare minutes of the conference for the case record, that a copy of these minutes would be provided to all parties, and that all parties would be given an opportunity to submit written comments upon those minutes.

Mr. Edelman stated that South Anderson would like to amend its tariff language giving the district the ability to pay back real estate developers over a ten-year period instead of immediately upon request by the developer. He further noted that the district would withdraw its petition for a deviation to totally discontinue all paybacks to real estate developers if appropriate tariff language could be agreed upon spreading the payback over the entire ten-year period.

Unequal treatment of customers was discussed as was the possibility of requiring notice to be given concerning the change in policy by the district. Finally, the issue of the possibility of interest payments was discussed. Commission Staff agreed to submit draft tariff language to South Anderson by July 12, 2006.

The conference then adjourned.
