Case. No. 2006-00151

The West Shelby Water District respectfully requests that the Public Service Commission allow us to make an adjustment in our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustments for Water Districts.

Our supplier, Louisville Water Company, has informed the District that an increase will take effect May 1, 2006. The District purchased 294,074,300 gallons of water from April 1, 2006 through March 31, 2006 at a total cost of \$471.023.20. The District sold 255,047,900 gallons of water to its customers. With the wholesale increase the new cost is expected to be \$485,946.59. The difference between the old cost and new cost will be \$14,923.39. The incremental cost in terms of water sold is \$0.06 (\$0.0585) cents per 1,000 gallons. We propose to raise each gallonage block that amount.

On behalf of Louisville Water Company, thank you for attending the meeting of our wholesale customers a few weeks ago. We always appreciate the opportunity for feedback from this important customer group of our Company. Please find enclosed a copy of the comments made at the meeting by Bob Miller.

Also enclosed is a copy of the 2006 Rate Schedule. As indicated in paragraph 6.03 of the schedule, the rate for wholesale water service on and after May 1, 2006 will be \$1.38 per thousand gallons, plus an elevated service area surcharge of \$0.25 per thousand gallons. The elevated service area surcharge will remain at the 2005 rate.

This new rate is subject to approval by the Public Service Commission. We are planning to file the necessary documentation for the new rate with the PSC in early March.

Meeting with Wholesale Customers
Information on Plans for Water Rates and Ratemaking Process

Alimond Avenue Distribution Center January 20, 2006

- We met last on March 1, 2005 at the Payne Water Treatment Plant we're meeting earlier this year to provide more planning time for the notice of a rate increase. This is our third increase in water rates for wholesale customers after going ten years without an increase.
- At our previous meetings, we talked about two key points: the need to recover our cost of service and that moderate annual increases would be needed in the future.
 Let's review some of the issues that we covered during last year's discussion.
- At that time, I anticipated that an increase of not more than 13 cents per thousand gallons would be needed in 2006 for wholesale customers in our elevated service area. This would have resulted in a rate increase of 8.3%. I am pleased to report that although an increase will be needed this year, it will be 4.5% or 7 cents per thousand gallons. The lower increase is attributable to (1) an increase in the estimate for water sales in Jefferson County and (2) an update to the rate study model that phases out the allocation of standpipes and elevated storage to wholesale customers in our elevated service area.
- Louisville Water Company prepares an annual operating budget each year where we project our water sales and expenses for the coming year. We try to make these budgets as realistic as possible based on actual experience.
- Our water sales budget is based on consumption trends for each of our customer classes: residential, commercial, industrial and wholesale. We performed a detailed study of water consumption patterns last year, looking backward for thirty years and forward for twenty years. We have determined that residential and commercial sales per account have been declining, but this has been offset by an increase in the number of residential and commercial accounts. Industrial sales continue to decline at a faster pace and wholesale sales are increasing slightly. Overall, we are forecasting our water sales to remain relatively flat if we continue to increase the number of residential and commercial accounts.
- Our operating budget contains our best estimates for its three major components: operation and maintenance expenses (wages and benefits, materials and supplies, and power and chemicals), depreciation expenses (cost of the treatment plant and distribution system improvements spread over their useful life), and a return on rate base (the profit component of water rates).
- Then, based upon that budget as approved by the Board of Water Works, we prepare a cost-of-service-based rate study each year. This cost-of-service-based rate study is a methodology that we use based on best practices as recommended by the American Water Works Association and used by water utilities regulated by the Kentucky Public Service Commission. In this rate study, we compute what it

- costs to serve each of our customer classes. We break out our costs by customer classes because similar types of customers place similar types of demands on our production and delivery system.
- We then establish water rates that recover costs from each of our customer classes based on their consumption and the demand that they place on our system. For our retail customers, these rates are subject to approval by the Board of Water Works. For West Shelby, North Shelby, and North Nelson, these rates are further subject to approval by the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
- Here are the rate components that we are targeting to implement:

- We anticipate that we will need moderate annual increases in the future. Rates to our retail customers increased by 5% this year. As we indicated last year, we want to continue making certain that our wholesale customers are advised well in advance of our rate plans. So, for planning purposes, I anticipate that another increase of not more than 8 cents per thousand gallons will be needed in the second quarter of 2007. This represents an increase of 5% (7 cents or 5% in the general pressure area).
- I want to assure you that we have worked diligently to control our costs, and when we reduced our workforce by thirty employees or nearly seven percent in early 2004, we have kept our staffing at that same level. We see continued cost pressures on water treatment expenses for electric power and chemicals, labor related expenses for pensions and medical insurance, and distribution expenses for fuel and insurance. Plus, investments in new transmission mains and riverbank filtration require an additional borrowing this year.
- We are targeting to implement this new rate in the second quarter of 2006 (effective May 1st). We are willing to help communicate this issue to your governing boards, to your customers, and even to your local newspapers. And, for those of you regulated by the Public Service Commission, we will certainly provide whatever assistance that we can in preparing the documentation needed for filing.

The commodity charge for monthly usage within the **Shepherdsville Area** services under one (1) inch shall be computed in accordance with the following schedule:

6.02.03 Elevated Service Area Surcharge

All customers shall pay a surcharge of \$0.25 per thousand gallons if water must be delivered at a higher elevation than the general pressure plane served by the Crescent Hill / Cardinal Hill System, excluding customers in the Kentucky Turnpike #2, Goshen Utilities, and Shepherdsville services under one (1) inch areas.

6.03 Wholesale Customers

Wholesale customers which purchase water for resale wherever situated shall be charged: \$1.38 per thousand gallons for all water purchased, the elevated service area surcharge specified in Rule 6.02.3, if applicable, and the service charge specified in Rule 6.02.1. For 2006 these rates will go into effect for water service on and after May 1, 2006.

6.04 Fire Service Charges

The charge for fire service, where water may be taken for fire protection only, shall be in accordance with the following schedule. This charge will also be applicable to such fire hydrants as may be provided by private agencies.
