MOTION TO MODIFY THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The Attorney General submits this motion to modify the procedural schedule set forth in the Commission's Order of 27 March 2007. In support of his motion, the Attorney General notes that the Assistant Attorney General assigned to the case is scheduled to be out of the Office on Monday, April 30<sup>th</sup>, and Tuesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, the dates set by the Order of procedure for, respectively, an informal conference and a public hearing.
