September 12, 2006 Informal Conference

On September 12, 2006, at 10:00 a.m., those persons whose names appear on the attached sign-in sheet met to discuss procedural and substantive issues in these arbitration proceedings. John Selent, attorney for the Petitioners, introduced Douglas Meredith, a consultant from John Staurulakis Inc. Mr. Meredith and his firm have experience in producing TELRIC cost studies and are negotiating with at least two of the rural local exchange carriers ("RLECs") to provide services for them. Mr. Selent indicated that the TELRIC studies referenced in Commission orders could not be completed in a manner to comply with the existing procedural schedule. Three months would be needed to conduct the studies. The RLECs proposed that, during the pendency of completion of the TELRIC studies, the interim rate of 1.5 cents be continued. Paul Walters, on behalf of Cingular Wireless, argued that the interim rate is not improper for use after January 1, 2007. He proposed, instead, to use FCC proxy rates. Mr. Selent also asserted that TELRIC studies would cost approximately \$200,000.00 per RLEC.

According to Duo, it terminates approximately 5 million minutes per year for wireless carriers who do not have direct interconnection arrangements with Duo. Brandenburg indicated that it terminates approximately 6 million minutes of this traffic per year.

According to the CMRS providers, only three methodologies are appropriate for the transport and termination of traffic in question in these proceedings. These methodologies are: (1) bill-and-keep, (2) FCC proxy rates, and (3) forward-looking costing principles.

The issue of comparing BellSouth's existing switching and transport rate with the FCC proxy rates arose. According to Bill Atkinson of Sprint, the switching rates for BellSouth are .001197, whereas the switching rates for the FCC proxy are .004. Regarding transport, the rate for BellSouth is .000746, whereas the transport FCC proxy rate is .005.

Parties also discussed issues pending in addition to the rate. One of these issues is the method of interconnection. The parties are not in agreement as to whether third-party transit arrangements should be continued. We discussed the Commission's cases addressing third-party transit arrangements, including one involving Level 3, Case No. 2000-00404, and another one involving AT&T. The parties also mentioned other issues that are contested in the proceeding such as traffic factors, seven- or tendigit calling, and if the contracts would cover intra-state-only traffic.

We also discussed all pending motions:

- 1. There is a motion to bifurcate the proceeding which, according to the Petitioners, is essentially a motion to amend the procedural schedule. The CMRS providers have filed a response to this motion.
- 2. There is a motion to approve interconnection agreements in four of these cases. The CMRS providers have responded to these motions as well.
- 3. There is a motion to seek a rural exemption, modification, or suspension. The Petitioners notified parties at the informal conference that this motion will be withdrawn.

Phil Schenkenberg of Verizon Wireless and T-Mobile asked that the informal conference address issues of procedures for the public hearing, such as witness order and appropriate ways to cross-examine. The attorneys agreed to discuss these matters in detail prior to the public hearing. For this purpose, an attorney conference call has been scheduled for 11:30 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, on October 12. The conference may be joined by calling (502) 564-3940 and asking for extension 7098.

Commission Staff requested of the RLECs that they complete their issues matrix in the same format provided by the CMRS providers. It was agreed that this updated issues matrix would be due September 20, the same day that responses to the second data requests are due.
