Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

In connection with the Answer filed by Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") on June 13, 2006 to the Complaint of James Nolten Blair in the above-referenced docket, LG&E requested another opportunity to satisfy this Complaint following a final determination in nine pending complaints before the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission").¹

The Commission issued final orders in these cases on September 13, 2006 (Yuen), September 14, 2006 (Wilson), September 28, 2006 (White, Clem, Marshall and B&D Rentals), and on October 18, 2006 (Dennison, Wade, and Walton). In its most recent set of order, the Commission found that the provision which states that the property owner assumes responsibility for any

consumption and the Company's property and service in the absence of an active account is stricken as unreasonable. As a result, LG&E has adjusted Mr. Blair's account for service at 2323 South Sixth Street, Louisville, Kentucky in the total amount of \$979.48. Specifically, LG&E adjusted this account in the amounts of \$83.30 and \$138.15 for tampering and in the amounts of \$101.64 and \$656.39 for electric and gas consumption related to such tampering.
