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The gas and electric services for 2414 Pyle Dr. were to be turned off at my request on August 30, 2005. On November 8 they were found on again. On December 8 an electric meter being used from another address was removed by LG&E. In January a third meter was found in use. Gas was also being used. Bob White said the gas was turned off on February 10.

The house was broken into and vandalized 2 or 3 times. The gas was off when the electric meter was read on March 17. On March 26 the house burned. We were told that the gas and electricity were off according to the records. We faxed a request to have the gas line cut and disconnected at the property line. On April 26 we were told that the meter was still there so we asked to have it removed.

I did not turn on or authorize any utility service during this period. I don't know why services' were not locked off after the first illegal usage was discovered. I don't feel that I should owe this bill since service should have been locked off and I did not use any electricity of gas. I do not owe \$979.48 for service at 2414 Pyle Dr.
