
Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

This is a response to the letter dated March 12, 2007, from Douglas F. Brent on behalf of Bluegrass Telephone Company d/b/a Kentucky Telephone ("KTC"). Mr. Brent, on behalf of his client, is attempting to submit evidence into the record in the above-referenced case that he states is "not readily apparent from the existing record."

The above-referenced case is an arbitration proceeding between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Kentucky and SouthEast Telephone Company. Both Parties have filed their briefs in this case and the case should stand before the Commission on the record before it. For the reasons stated in AT&T Kentucky's brief, the Commission should find for AT&T Kentucky on Issue A-4 regarding off-site collocation.

KTC is not a party to this case and any "evidence" filed on its behalf in this case is inappropriate and should not be considered by the Commission in making its decision in this case. AT&T Kentucky, therefore, requests that Mr. Brent's letter of March 12, 2007, be excluded from the record in this case.
