

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**


Xspedius Communications, LLC (“Xspedius”), by counsel, hereby moves the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the “Commission”) for a three-week extension of time with respect to the dates by which the parties must take action in accordance with the Commission's procedural order entered in this matter on January 17, 2007. As grounds for this motion, Xspedius states as follows. The parties to this action are in agreement regarding permitting the extension of the Commission's procedural schedule. This additional time will allow the parties the opportunity to reach an agreement in this matter without the unnecessary expenditure of additional resources.

Therefore, Xspedius Communications, LLC respectfully requests the Commission to grant its motion for a three-week extension of all the deadlines set forth in the Commission's procedural order governing this matter. Accordingly, the new procedural deadlines would be as follows:

- 1) On or before February 20, 2007, Wispnet, LLC shall file its answer to the counterclaim of Xspedius.
- 2) On or before February 20, 2007, the parties may file their data requests with the Commission and serve a copy on all parties of record.

- 3) On or before March 6, 2007, the parties shall respond to all data requests.
- 4) On or before March 20, 2007, the parties shall notify the Commission if they request a formal hearing. If no hearing is requested by this date, the matter shall stand submitted to the Commission for a decision based on the existing record.


