MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Xspedius Communications, LLC (“Xspedius”), by counsel, hereby moves the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the “Commission”) for a seventeen-day extension of time with respect to the dates by which the parties must take action in accordance with the Commission's revised procedural order entered in this matter on January 30, 2007. In support of its motion, Xspedius states as follows.

Xspedius and Wispnet, LLC (“Wispnet”) are actively engaged in resolving this dispute. The parties and the parties’ counsel have had several conversations and have been diligently working toward a final resolution. Due to scheduling conflicts, however, the parties require additional time to reach an agreement in this matter. Therefore, the parties agree that a seventeen-day extension of time would assist the parties in settling this matter without unnecessarily expending the parties’ and the Commission’s resources.

Therefore, Xspedius Communications, LLC respectfully requests the Commission to grant its motion for a seventeen-day extension of all the deadlines set forth in the Commission's revised procedural order governing this matter. Accordingly, the new procedural deadlines would be as follows:


1) On or before March 9, 2007, Wispnet, LLC shall file its answer to the counterclaim of Xspedius.

2) On or before March 9, 2007, the parties may file their data requests with the Commission and serve a copy on all parties of record.

3) On or before March 23, 2007, the parties shall respond to all data requests.

4) On or before April 6, 2007, the parties shall notify the Commission if they request a formal hearing. If no hearing is requested by this date, the matter shall stand submitted to the Commission for a decision based on the existing record.


