MOTION TO REOPEN CASE

This Motion of the Grayson County Water District ("Applicant"), respectfully shows:

That on September 2, 2005, Applicant submitted an application for a Certificate of 1. Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a \$2,500,000 waterworks improvement project (the "Project") and for approval of its plan of financing for this project. On September 29, 2005, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 2005-00358 granting the Certificate and approving the financing.

That the U.S. Department of Agriculture, acting through Rural Development ("RD") 2. issued Amendment No. 2, dated August 29, 2006, to the original Letter of Conditions (a copy of said Amendment is attached to this Motion), which Amendment sets forth a revised rate schedule for Applicant in order to generate sufficient income and revenues to cover increased operation and maintenance expenses and increased debt service requirements on the \$1,350,000 RD loan.

3. That the Project is currently under construction and, as of this date, RD has not expended any loan proceeds on the Project and the RD loan has not been closed. Applicant is required to meet all of the conditions in the RD Letter of Conditions, including Amendments thereto, in order for RD to close the loan.

That Applicant files this Motion to request that the Commission reopen Case No. 4 2005-00358 and issue its Order approving the proposed rate change as set forth in Amendment No. 2 of the RD Letter of Conditions.

5. That Applicant files herewith the following Exhibits pursuant to 807 KAR 5:069 in support of this Application:

- A. Copy of Amendment No. 2 to the RD Letter of Conditions.
- B. Certified statement from the Chairman of Applicant, based upon statements of the Engineers for Applicant, concerning the following:
 - The proposed plans and specifications for the Project have been designed to meet the minimum construction and operating requirements set out in 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(3) and (4); Section 5(1); Sections 6 and 7; Section 8(1) through (3); Section 9(1) and Section 10;
 - (2) All other state approvals or permits have already been obtained;
 - (3) The proposed rates of Applicant shall produce the total revenue requirements set out in the final engineering report; and
 - (4) Setting out the dates when it is anticipated that construction will begin and end.

6. That Applicant has arranged for the publication, prior to or at the same time this Application is filed, of a Notice of Proposed Rate Change pursuant to Section 2 of 807 KAR 5:069, in The Record, which is the newspaper of general circulation in Applicant's service area and in Grayson County, Kentucky. Said Notice sets out the Applicant's current rates and proposed rates and a short description of the Project. A copy of said Notice is filed herewith as an Exhibit.

WHEREFORE, Applicant, the Grayson County Water District, asks that the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky reopen **Case No. 2005-00358** and issue its Order approving the proposed increased rates as set out in Section 25 of Amendment No. 2 to the RD Letter of Conditions.
