KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY'S AND LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION FOR INFORMAL CONFERENCE

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") and Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") (collectively "the Companies") hereby move the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to schedule an informal conference on Thursday, May 31, 2007, at 1:00 p.m. (Eastern Time) for the purpose of addressing the question raised by Commission Staff during the hearing on May 10, 2007, concerning a reconciliation of all Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. ("MISO") costs and revenues. As grounds for their Motion, KU and LG&E offer the following:

At the hearing on May 10th, Commission Staff asked the Companies' witness whether the Companies would be willing to reconcile all MISO costs and revenues in the next general rate case as an adjustment even if it was outside the time period in which they were incurred. The Companies' witness appropriately declined to make the requested commitment from the

witness stand. The Companies were surprised by the question for two reasons: (1) the Commission had previously denied the Companies' proposal for deferral accounting of MISO Day-2 costs and revenues;² and (2) the adjustment proposed in the question is contrary to historic ratemaking principals and may violate the prohibition against retroactive ratemaking.³

Moreover, assuming solely for the sake of the argument that such an adjustment to base rates would be reasonable and legal, the net result would harm customers by building into base rates on a going-forward basis, a non-recurring net expense. The Commission Staff question and the Companies' answer, however, may have created the impression that the Companies have something to hide or are reluctant to be forthcoming on this issue. That is simply not the case.

Though the Companies have serious reservations about such an adjustment to the test period in the next base rate case, KU and LG&E desire to directly address this issue and answer any questions the Commission Staff or intervenors may have about it in order to remove any cloud of suspicion or negative inference left by the Companies' answer at the hearing.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company hereby request the Commission to issue an order scheduling an informal conference in this matter on Thursday, May 31, 2007, at 1:30 p.m. (Eastern Time) for the purpose of addressing the question raised by the Commission Staff at the hearing on May 10, 2007.
