Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure its legibility.

Each response shall be under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation, a partnership, an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Fleming-Mason shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though

correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which

Fleming-Mason fails to furnish all or part of the requested information, Fleming-Mason

shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely

and precisely respond.

When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding

in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that

information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information

shall be provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations, separately.
