COMMENTS: As a former Owen County resident
and an Aquatic Biologist, I strongly oppose
the Kentucky American Water pipeline project.
This project will cause horrific destruction to
the natural habitats that contain a wide diversity
of plants and animals in Owen County. As of
January 2, 2002 there are three Endangered
Species in Owen County, Kentucky. These
species include the clubshell - Pleurobema clava,
Fanshell - Cyprogenia stegaria and Small rock
crass - Arabis perstellata. The first two being
freshwater mussels of Kentucky and the third
(Arabis perstellata) being a plant which heppened
to be collected in 1936 and 1939 on the hillside
of the Elkhorn Creek.

As an Aquatic Biologist, the emant of freshwater
invertebrates that will be affected by this project
proposed by Kentucky American Water, breaks
my heart. I ask the Public Service Commission
of Kentucky to please consider a route that
will be more Environmentally Friendly, preserving
the many organisms and the beethful land of
Owen County.
