To Whom It May Concern:

We wish to express our disfavor for the Kentucky American Water Company's proposal to build a treatment plant on pool 3 of the Kentucky River. The cost of their proposal to build this plant and then a pipeline from the Ohio River is excessive. The cost to the customers who will have to pay for this proposal is not fair when there is an alternative at much less cost. We do not feel that Kentucky American is doing what is in the best interests of its customers; they are doing what will benefit their stockholders. If this were a public utility, this proposal would not be before you because a public utility would be looking for the most cost-effective way to serve its customers.

Central Kentucky needs to look beyond depending on the Kentucky River if there is more draught and if there are several successive years of draught. With what is happening with global warming and the possible problems ahead, this proposal is not in the best interests of central Kentucky at the proposed cost.

Property owners along the route from this treatment plant to Lexington should not have their properties destroyed for the benefit of foreign stockholders.

We hope the PSC will not find in favor of this plan.
