COMMENTS: I am strongly opposed to the Kentucky American plan. Based on the company's track record of rate increases (to enhance their capital assets — not to serve the public interest), we can expect an ongoing series of rate increases that will damage the economy of central Kentucky. Furthermore, Kentucky-American has shown deception in cooking their figures to make their project appear less costly than it will actually be, and in concealing the part of their plan that involves building an additional pipeline from Monterey to the Ohio River in the future.

The alternate plan to bring water from Louisville along I-64 will tap into an unlimited source (the Ohio River), ~~which~~ will have less negative (and costly) impact on the yards, farmlands, and existing roads of central Kentucky. It is a more cost effective solution, updated since 1993 to avoid the objections voiced at that time, that will keep the control of central Kentucky's water supply in the hands of a Kentucky company that is not foreign-owned and not on sale in the international market.
