APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CORBIN STATION)

Bluegrass Wireless LLC ("Bluegrass Wireless"), through counsel, pursuant to KRS 278.020 and 278.040, hereby submits this application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct a cell site to be known as the Corbin Station cell site in and for rural service area ("RSA") #11 of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, namely the counties of Bell, Clay, Harlan, Knox, Leslie and Whitley, Kentucky.

- 1. As required by 807 KAR 5:001 Sections 8(l) and (3), and 807 KAR 5:063, Bluegrass Wireless states that it is a Kentucky limited liability company whose full name and post office address are: Bluegrass Wireless LLC, 2902 Ring Road, Elizabethtown, Kentucky, 42701.
- 2. Pursuant to 807 KAR § 1 (1)(b), a copy of the applicant's applications to the Federal Aviation Administration and Kentucky Airport Zoning Commission are Exhibit "A". Written authorizations from these agencies will be supplied to the Commission upon their approval.
- 3. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(d), a geotechnical investigation report, signed and sealed by a professional engineer registered in Kentucky, that includes boring logs,

foundation design recommendations, and a finding as to the proximity of the proposed site to flood hazard areas is attached as Exhibit "B".

- 4. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(e), clear directions from the county seat to the proposed site, including highway numbers and street names, if applicable, with the telephone number of the person who prepared the directions are attached as Exhibit "C".
- 5. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(f), a copy of the lease (or sale agreement) for the property on which the tower is proposed to be located is attached as Exhibit "D".
- 6. Pursuant to 807 KAR §1(1)(g), experienced personnel will manage and operate the Corbin Station cell site. The President of Bluegrass Cellular Inc., Mr. Ron Smith, is ultimately responsible for all construction and operations of the cellular system of Bluegrass Wireless, of which system the Corbin Station cell site will be a part. Bluegrass Cellular Inc. provides management services to Bluegrass Wireless under a management contract, just as it does with three (3) other wireless carriers in the Commonwealth. And, Bluegrass Cellular Inc. has been providing these management services to these other wireless carriers for well over a decade. This extensive management experience with Bluegrass Cellular demonstrates that Bluegrass Cellular Inc.'s management and technical ability to supervise the operations of a wireless carrier.
- 7. Pursuant to 807 KAR §1(1)(g), Eastpointe Engineering Group, LLC is responsible for the design specifications of the proposed tower (identified in Exhibit "B").
- 8. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(h), a site development plan or survey, signed and sealed by a professional engineer registered in Kentucky, that shows the proposed location of the tower and all easements and existing structures within 500 feet of the proposed site on the property on which the tower will be located, and all easements and existing structures within 200

feet of the access drive, including the intersection with the public street system, is attached as Exhibit "B".

- 9. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(i), a vertical profile sketch of the tower, signed and sealed by a professional engineer registered in Kentucky, indicating the height of the tower and the placement of all antennas is attached as Exhibit "B".
- 10. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(j), the tower and foundation design plans and a description of the standard according to which the tower was designed, signed and sealed by a professional engineer registered in Kentucky is attached as Exhibit "B".
- 11. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 § 1 (1)(k), a map, drawn to a scale no less than one (1) inch equals 200 feet, that identifies every structure and every owner of real estate within 500 feet of the proposed tower is attached as Exhibit "E".
- 12. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 § 1 (1)(1), applicant's legal counsel hereby affirms that every person who owns property within 500 feet of the proposed tower has been: (i) notified by certified mail, return receipt requested, of the proposed construction; (ii) given the commission docket number under which the application will be processed; and (iii) informed of his or her right to request intervention.
- Pursuant to KRS 278.665(2), applicant's legal counsel hereby affirms that every person who, according to the records of the property valuation administrator, owns property contiguous to the property where the proposed cellular antenna tower will be located has been:

 (i) notified by certified mail, return receipt requested, of the proposed construction; (ii) given the commission docket number under which the application will be processed; and (iii) informed of his or her right to request intervention.

- 14. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(m), a list of the property owners who received the notice together with copies of the certified letters sent to listed property owners is attached as Exhibit "F".
- 15. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 § 1 (1)(n), applicant's legal counsel hereby affirms that the office of the Knox County Judge Executive has been: (i) notified by certified mail, return receipt requested, of the proposed construction; (ii) given the commission docket number under which the application will be processed; and (iii) informed of its right to request intervention.
- 16. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(o), a copy of the notice sent to the office of the Knox County Judge Executive is attached as Exhibit "G".
- 17. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 § 1 (1)(p), applicant's legal counsel hereby affirms that (i) two written notices meeting subsection two (2) of this section have been posted, one in a visible location on the proposed site and one on the nearest public road; and (ii) the notices shall remain posted for at least two weeks after the application has been filed.
 - 18. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 § 1 (2)(a), applicant's legal counsel affirms that:
 - (a) A written notice, of durable material at least two (2) feet by four (4) feet in size, stating that "Bluegrass Wireless LLC proposes to construct a telecommunications tower on this site," including the addresses and telephone numbers of the applicant and the Kentucky Public Service Commission, has been posted and shall remain in a visible location on the proposed site until final disposition of the application; and
 - (b) A written notice, of durable material at least two (2) feet by four (4) feet in size, stating that "Bluegrass Wireless LLC proposes to construct a telecommunications tower near this site," including the addresses and telephone numbers of the applicant and the Kentucky Public Service Commission, has been posted on the public road nearest the site.

A copy of each sign is attached as Exhibit "H".

- 19. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 § 1 (1)(q), a statement that notice of the location of the proposed construction has been published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the construction is proposed is attached as Exhibit "I".
- 20. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 § 1(1)(r), the cell site which has been selected is in a commercially developed area in Corbin, Knox County, Kentucky, which is outside the city limits of Corbin.
- 21. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 §1(1)(s), Bluegrass Wireless has considered the likely effects of the installation on nearby land uses and values and has concluded that there is no more suitable location reasonably available from which adequate service to the area can be provided, and that there is no reasonably available opportunity to co-locate. Bluegrass Wireless has attempted to co-locate on towers designed to host multiple wireless service providers' facilities or existing structures, such as a telecommunications tower, or another suitable structure capable of supporting the utility's facilities.
- 22. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 § 1(1)(t), a map of the area in which the tower is proposed to be located, that is drawn to scale and that clearly depicts the search area in which a site should, pursuant to radio frequency requirements, be located is attached Exhibit "J".
- 23. Pursuant to KAR 100.987(2)(a), a grid map, that is drawn to scale, that shows the location of all existing cellular antenna towers and that indicates the general position of proposed construction sites for new cellular antenna towers is attached as Exhibit "K".
- 24. No reasonably available telecommunications tower, or other suitable structure capable of supporting the cellular facilities of Bluegrass Wireless and which would provide adequate service to the area exists.







1.0 INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to describe the subsurface conditions encountered in the boring, analyze and evaluate the test data, and provide recommendations regarding the design and construction of the foundation and earthwork for the proposed tower. One boring extending to a depth of about 42 feet below the existing ground surface was drilled at the site. An individual boring log and a boring location plan are included with this report.

2.0 PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Terracon understands the proposed project will consist of the construction of a 180-foot monopole tower. Exact tower loads are not available, but based on our past experience are anticipated to be as follows:

Vertical Load:

40 kips

Horizontal Shear:

30 kips

Overturning Moment:

3,600 kip-ft

A small, lightly loaded equipment building will also be constructed. Wall and floor loads for this building are not anticipated to exceed 1 kip per linear foot and 100 pounds per square foot, respectively. The subject site consists of an approximate 100- by 100-foot, gently sloping parcel located in an asphalt-paved parking lot of the Corbin Station Shopping Center. The ground surface elevation at the tower is approximately 1,180 feet.

3.0 EXPLORATION PROCEDURES

3.1 Field Exploration

The subsurface exploration consisted of drilling and sampling one boring at the site to a depth of about 42 feet below existing grade. The boring was advanced at the center of the tower, staked by the project surveyor. The ground surface elevation at the boring location was interpolated from contours on the Corbin, Kentucky quadrangle topographic map. The location and elevation of the boring should be considered accurate only to the degree implied by the means and methods used to define them.

The boring was drilled with an ATV-mounted rotary drill rig using hollow stem augers to advance the borehole. Representative soil samples were obtained by the split-barrel

sampling procedure in general accordance with the appropriate standard. In the split-barrel sampling procedure, the number of blows required to advance a standard 2-inch O.D. split-barrel sampler the last 12 inches of the typical total 18-inch penetration by means of a 140-pound hammer with a free fall of 30 inches, is the standard penetration resistance (SPT) value (N-Value). This value is used to estimate the in-situ relative density of cohesionless soils and the consistency of cohesive soils. The sampling depths, penetration distance, and SPT N-Values are shown on the boring log. The samples were sealed and delivered to the laboratory for testing and classification.

A field log of the boring was prepared by a subcontract driller. This log included visual classifications of the materials encountered during drilling as well as the driller's interpretation of the subsurface conditions between samples. The final boring log included with this report represents an interpretation of the driller's field log and a visual classification of the soil samples made by the Geotechnical Engineer.

3.2 Laboratory Testing

The samples were classified in the laboratory based on visual observation, texture and plasticity. The descriptions of the soils indicated on the boring log are in accordance with the enclosed General Notes and the Unified Soil Classification System. Estimated group symbols according to the Unified Soil Classification System are given on the boring log. A brief description of this classification system is attached to this report.

The laboratory testing program consisted of performing water content tests and an Atterberg Limits test on representative soil samples. Information from these tests was used in conjunction with field penetration test data to evaluate soil strength in-situ, volume change potential, and soil classification. Results of these tests are provided on the boring log.

4.0 EXPLORATORY FINDINGS

4.1 Subsurface Conditions

Conditions encountered at the boring location are indicated on the boring log. Stratification boundaries on the boring log represent the approximate location of changes in soil types and the transition between materials may be gradual. Water levels shown on the boring log represent the conditions only at the time of our exploration. Based on the results of the boring, subsurface conditions on the project site can be generalized as follows.

Underlying approximately 4 inches of asphalt and 13 inches of stone base, our boring encountered lean clay (CL) to depth of about 18½ feet below existing grade. The lean clay generally exhibited a medium stiff to stiff consistency in the upper 8 feet based on SPT N-values ranging from 5 to 10 blows per foot (bpf). Below this depth, the profile stiffens with

N-values in excess of 26 bpf. Weathered shale was encountered below the lean clay extending to auger refusal at a depth of about 42 feet below existing grade. SPT N-values in excess of 50 bpf were encountered in the zone of weathered shale.

4.2 Site Geology

A review of the Geologic Map of Corbin Quadrangle published by the United States Geological Survey (USGS) indicates that the site is underlain by Breathitt Formation of the Carbonaceous age. This formation is comprised of sandstone, siltstone, shale, limestone and coal beds. The sandstone and limestone are light-gray to gray and weather to yellowish-gray. The shale and siltstone are gray to dark gray.

4.3 Groundwater Conditions

Groundwater was not observed in the boring during or immediately after completion of drilling operations. At the time the boring was drilled, the groundwater table at the boring location was apparently below the maximum drilling depth. However, fluctuations in the groundwater table can occur and perched water can develop over low permeability soil or rock strata following periods of heavy or prolonged precipitation. This possibility should be considered when developing plans and specifications for the project. Long term monitoring in cased holes or piezometers would be necessary to accurately evaluate the potential range of groundwater conditions on the site.

5.0 ENGINEERING RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the encountered subsurface conditions, the tower can be constructed on a drilled pier or buried footing. The lightly loaded equipment building can be supported on shallow spread footings. Foundation recommendations are presented in the following paragraphs.

5.1 Tower Foundation

The above indicated cohesion, friction angle, lateral subgrade modulus and strain values have no factors of safety, and the allowable skin friction and the passive resistances have factors of safety of 2. The cohesion, internal friction angle, lateral subgrade modulus and strain values given in the above table are based on the boring, published correlation values and Terracon's past experience with similar material types. These values should, therefore, be considered approximate. The allowable end bearing pressure provided in the table has an approximate factor of safety of at least 3. Total settlement of a drilled pier designed using the above parameters is not anticipated to exceed 1 inch.

The upper 3 feet of lean clay should be ignored due to the potential affects of frost action and construction disturbance. To avoid a reduction in lateral and uplift resistance caused by variable subsurface conditions, the drawings should instruct the contractor to notify the engineer if subsurface conditions significantly different than encountered in the boring are disclosed during drilled pier installation. Under these circumstances, it may be necessary to adjust the overall length of the pier. To facilitate these adjustments and assure that the pier is embedded in suitable materials, it is recommended that a Terracon representative observe the drilled pier excavation.

Although the boring was able to penetrate the highly weathered shale, it is likely that larger diameter drilled pier equipment will refuse on this material at higher elevations than shown in our boring. The contractor should recognize the hardness of the material and be prepared to use rock teeth or other means to extend through these layers.

A drilled pier foundation should be designed with a minimum shaft diameter of 30 inches to facilitate clean out and possible dewatering of the pier excavation. Temporary casing may be required during the pier excavation in order to control possible groundwater seepage and

support the sides of the excavation in weak soil zones. Care should be taken so that the sides and bottom of the excavations are not disturbed during construction. The bottom of the shaft should be free of loose soil or debris prior to reinforcing steel and concrete placement.

A concrete slump of at least 6 inches is recommended to facilitate temporary casing removal. It should be possible to remove the casing from a pier excavation during concrete placement provided that the concrete inside the casing is maintained at a sufficient level to resist any earth and hydrostatic pressures outside the casing during the entire casing removal procedure.

Buried Foundation Alternative: A shallow footing, bearing on native stiff soils at a depth of at least six feet below existing grade or on properly compacted fill extending to suitable native soils at this depth, could be designed for a maximum net allowable soil bearing pressure of 2,500 psf. In using net allowable soil pressures for footing dimensioning, the weight of the footing and backfill over the footing need not be considered.

To resist lateral loads, an ultimate friction factor of 0.35 can be taken between the foundation and underlying soil. Lateral resistance due to friction at the base of the footing should be ignored where uplift also occurs. Additional lateral resistance can be determined using a coefficient of passive earth pressure (K) equal to 2.8 and a unit weight of soil of about 115 pcf. This would result in an equivalent fluid pressure of about 325 pounds per cubic foot (pcf). If the pedestal is formed, backfill around this structure should be compacted to a minimum of 98 percent of standard Proctor maximum dry density. We recommend a factor of safety of at least 2 be applied to obtain an allowable passive resistance.

Uplift forces can be resisted by the dead weight of the footing and the effective weight of any soil above the footing. A unit weight of soil not exceeding 110 pcf is appropriate for the on-site soils backfilled above the foundation, assuming that it is compacted to at least 95 percent of standard Proctor maximum dry density (ASTM D-698). The ground surface should be sloped away from the foundation to avoid ponding of water and saturation of the backfill materials.

5.2 Equipment Building Foundations

The proposed equipment shed may be supported on shallow footings bearing on stiff natural soils. The equipment building foundations should be dimensioned using a net allowable soil bearing pressure of 1,500 pounds per square foot (psf). In using net allowable soil pressures for footing dimensioning, the weight of the footings and backfill over the footings need not be considered. Furthermore, the footings should be at least 12 inches wide and a minimum of 2 feet square.

The geotechnical engineer or a qualified representative should observe the foundation excavations to verify that the bearing materials are suitable for support of the proposed loads.

If, at the time of such observation, any soft soils are encountered at the design foundation elevation, the excavations should be extended downward so that the footings rest on stiff soils. If it is inconvenient to lower the footings, the proposed footing elevations may be re-established by backfilling after the undesirable material has been removed.

The recommended soil bearing value should be considered an upper limit, and any value less than that listed above would be acceptable for the foundation system. Using the value given, total settlement would be about 1 inch or less with differential settlements being less than 75 percent of total settlement. Footings should be placed at a depth of 2 feet, or greater, below finished exterior grade for protection against frost damage.

5.3 Parking and Drive Areas

The drive that accesses the site will be surfaced with crushed stone. Parking and drive areas that are surfaced with crushed stone should have a minimum thickness of 6 inches and be properly placed and compacted as outlined herein. The crushed stone should meet Kentucky Transportation Cabinet specifications and applicable local codes.

A paved section consisting only of crushed graded aggregate base course should be considered a high maintenance section. Regular care and maintenance is considered essential to the longevity and use of the section. Site grades should be maintained in such a manner as to allow for adequate surface runoff. Any potholes, depressions or excessive rutting that may develop should be repaired as soon as possible to reduce the possibility of degrading the soil subgrade.

5.4 Site Preparation

Site preparation should begin with the removal of any topsoil, loose, soft or otherwise unsuitable materials from the construction area. The geotechnical engineer should evaluate the actual stripping depth, along with any soft soils that require undercutting at the time of construction.

Any fill and backfill placed on the site should consist of approved materials that are free of organic matter and debris. Suitable fill materials should consist of well graded crushed stone below the tower foundation and well graded crushed stone or low plasticity cohesive soil elsewhere. Low-plasticity cohesive soil should have a liquid limit of less than 45 percent and a plasticity index of less than 25 percent. The on site soils are considered suitable for re-use as fill. It is recommended that during construction these soils be further tested and evaluated prior to use as fill. Fill should not contain frozen material and it should not be placed on a frozen subgrade.

The fill should be placed and compacted in lifts of 9 inches or less in loose thickness. Fill placed below structures or used to provide lateral resistance should be compacted to at least

98 percent of the material's maximum standard Proctor dry density (ASTM D-698). Fill should be placed, compacted, and maintained at moisture contents within minus 1 to plus 3 percent of the optimum value determined by the standard Proctor test.

The geotechnical engineer should be retained to monitor fill placement on the project and to perform field density tests as each lift of fill is placed in order to evaluate compliance with the design requirements. Standard Proctor and Atterberg limits tests should be performed on the representative samples of fill materials before their use on the site.

6.0 GENERAL COMMENTS


Terracon should be retained to review the final design plans and specifications so comments can be made regarding interpretation and implementation of our geotechnical recommendations in the design and specifications. Terracon also should be retained to provide testing and observation during excavation, grading, foundation and construction phases of the project.

The analysis and recommendations presented in this report are based upon the data obtained from the boring performed at the indicated location and from other information discussed in this report. This report does not reflect variations that may occur across the site, or due to the modifying effects of weather. The nature and extent of such variations may not become evident until during or after construction. If variations appear, we should be immediately notified so that further evaluation and supplemental recommendations can be provided.

The scope of services for this project does not include either specifically or by implication any environmental or biological (e.g., mold, fungi, bacteria) assessment of the site or identification or prevention of pollutants, hazardous materials or conditions. If the owner is concerned about the potential for such contamination or pollution, other studies should be undertaken.

This report has been prepared for the exclusive use of our client for specific application to the project discussed and has been prepared in accordance with generally accepted geotechnical engineering practices. No warranties, either express or implied, are intended or made. Site safety, excavation support, and dewatering requirements are the responsibility of others. In the event that changes in the nature, design, or location of the project as outlined in this report are planned, the conclusions and recommendations contained in this report shall not be considered valid unless Terracon reviews the changes and either verifies or modifies the conclusions of this report in writing.

OPTION TO LEASE AND LEASE AGREEMENT

I. OPTION TO LEASE REAL PROPERTY

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Optionor(s) is the owner of certain real property located in <u>Knox</u> County, <u>Kentucky</u> as more particularly described on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Optionor(s) wishes to grant to the Optionee and the Optionee wishes to obtain from the Optionor(s), an option to lease the Property upon the terms and conditions set forth herein;

NOW, **THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing premises and for other good and valuable consideration, the mutuality, receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto do agree as follows.

1. In consideration of <u>Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$500.00)</u> paid by the Optionee to the Optionor(s) (the "Option Consideration"), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the Optionor(s), the Optionor(s) hereby grants to the Optionee an exclusive and irrevocable option to lease the Property (the "Option"), upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, upon the exercise of the Option at any time before 4:00 p.m. prevailing time on <u>October 1, 2006</u>, as set forth in Paragraph <u>5</u> thereof.

- The parties hereto anticipate that the Property comprises approximately three 2. sections: 1) an approximately Forty-five Foot by Eighteen Foot (45' by 18') area, 2) an approximately Twelve Foot Six Inch by Twelve Foot Six Inch (12'6" by 12' 6") area, and 3) an approximately Twenty Foot by Twenty Foot area. Rights of way will be given by the Optionor(s) for the purposes of ingress and egress to all three sections throughout the term of the lease, with the exception that Optionee shall no longer have access to or use of the Forty-five Foot by Eighteen Foot (45' by 18') section after the Optionee erects an operational communications tower and receives all Governmental Approvals associated therewith as described in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Lease Agreement. The Optionee shall obtain an accurate survey of the Property by a registered land surveyor licensed in the Commonwealth of Kentucky at the sole expense of the Optionee. A copy of the survey shall be provided to the Optionor(s). The description of the Property shall include the number of acres determined by the surveyor. The Optionee shall obtain said survey within a reasonable time following the date of the Option Agreement.
- 3. During the term of the Option, the Optionee may enter onto the Property at its own risk to obtain soil samples and to bore soil for the purposes of determining the suitability of the Property for a communications tower.

4. Upon the Optionee's proper exercise of the Option in accordance with Paragraph 5 hereof, the Optionor(s) shall be deemed to have immediately executed, acknowledged and delivered to the Optionee the Lease Agreement contained in Section II hereof. The description of the Property shall be that determined by the registered land surveyor in accordance with Paragraph 2 hereof. Lee Hackel Exhibit:

- 5. If the Optionee elects to exercise the Option in accordance with the terms hereof, notice of such election shall be deemed sufficient if personally delivered or sent by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, to the address of the Optionor(s) set forth in Paragraph 14 hereof.
- 6. The Optionor(s) agrees not to sell, lease or offer for sale or lease the Property during the term of this Option or any renewal or extension of the Option.
- 7. In the event the Optionee fails to exercise the Option as set forth herein (unless such failure is due to the discovery of a defect in the Property or other matter unsatisfactory to the Optionee), the Optionor(s) shall have the right to retain the Option Consideration.
- 8. The Optionee may assign this Option with written consent of the Optionor(s), which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, and upon any assignment such assignee shall have all the rights, remedies and obligations as if it were the original Optionee hereunder. From and after any such assignment, the term "Optionee" shall refer to such assignee.
- 9. Each party hereto shall bear any and all of its own expenses in connection with the negotiation, execution or settlement of this Option.

- 10. Risk of loss with respect to the Property during the term of this Option and during the term of the lease shall be upon the Optionor(s). If, during the term of the Option, any portion of the Property shall be acquired by public authority under the right or threat of eminent domain, the Optionee may, at its sole option, either (i) exercise the Option, and in such event, all sums received from the public authority by the Optionor(s) by reason of the taking of a portion of the Property shall reduce the rent due under the lease, or (ii) terminate this Option and thereupon the Optionor(s) shall be obligated to return to the Optionee the full amount of the Option Consideration previously paid to the Optionor(s) in "good and collected funds."
- 11. The parties hereto represent to each other that neither has engaged any broker to represent their interests in connection with the transactions contemplated hereby, and each agrees to indemnify the other against any and all claims made by any brokers engaged or purported to be engaged by the other for brokerage commissions or fees in connection with the transactions contemplated hereby.
- 12. The Optionor(s) represents, warrants and covenants to the Optionee that the Optionor(s) has not caused or permitted, and shall not cause or permit, and to the best of Optionor(s)' knowledge no other person has caused or permitted any hazardous material (as defined by any applicable federal, state or local law, rule or regulation) to be brought upon, placed, held, located or disposed of at the Property. In the event any such contamination occurs for which the Optionee becomes legally liable, the Optionor(s) shall indemnify the Optionee against all claims, damages, judgments, penalties and costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, which Optionee may incur.

13. This Option Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties hereto shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

- 14. For the purposes of giving notice as permitted or required herein, the address of the Optionor(s)shall be: <u>PO Box 1546, Corbin Kentucky 40702</u> the Optionee's address shall be 2902 Ring Road, Elizabethtown, KY 42701.
- 15. The Optionee shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to record this Option in the Office of the Clerk of the County Court of **Knox** County, **Kentucky**.

II.

LEASE AGREEMENT

- 16. In the event the Optionee elects to exercise the Option to lease the Property, the terms of the lease shall become immediately effective upon such exercise and shall be as follows.
 - 1. The term of the lease shall commence on the date that the Optionor(s) receives proper notice that the Optionee has exercised the Option, pursuant to Paragraph 5 therein. The initial term shall expire five (5) year(s) from the commencement date of the lease agreement and shall include three (3) additional five (5)-year terms per the lease agreement. Optionee may, by providing written notice at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the original or any renewal lease term, elect to unilaterally terminate this lease at the end of any original or renewal lease term. Such notice must be personally delivered or sent via registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, to the address of the Optioner(s) set forth in Paragraph 14 hereof. The lease

amount shall be adjusted at the end of each term by an increase of 10%.

- The Optionee shall pay to the Optionor(s) rent for the Property in the sum of Twenty One Thousand Six Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$21,600.00) yearly, to be paid in advance. All rent payments shall be personally delivered or mailed to the Optionor(s) at the address set forth in Paragraph 14 hereof. Any check payment of the rent due under the lease shall be payable to the order of Optionor(s).
- 3. The Optionee shall be entitled to use and occupy the Property for the purpose of erecting and maintaining a communications tower thereon and for such other uses as Optionee may deem necessary in connection therewith. Optionor(s) hereby agrees that Optionee may install, maintain and operate a Cell on Wheels (COW) on the Property for a period of 18 months or until such time as Optionee erects an operational communications tower and receives all Governmental Approvals as defined in paragraph 4 below. In the event that Optionee has not erected an operational communications tower and received all Governmental Approvals, as defined in paragraph 4 below, within 18 months from the Effective Date of this Lease Agreement, Optionee must immediately remove the Cell on Wheels (COW) from the Property, and this Option to Lease and Lease Agreement shall terminate, without penalty, at that time, and Optionee shall be entitled to a pro rata refund of the second year's rent within thirty (30) days of Optionee's written demand for the same.
- 4. Optionor(s) and Optionee understand and agree that Optionee may terminate this Lease Agreement without penalty and upon thirty (30) days notice if

Optionee is unable to obtain all governmental licenses, permits and approvals required of Optionee to erect, maintain and operate a communications tower on the Property, including without limitation applications for zoning variances, administrative or special use permits, and building and land disturbance permits (collectively referred to as "Governmental Approvals"). Optionee shall have the right, without obligation to do so, to appeal any denial by a governmental agency. Optionor(s) agrees to make reasonable efforts to cooperate with Optionee and join in any application for Governmental Approvals, provided, however, that Optionor(s) shall be reimbursed by Optionee for any of Optionor(s)'s reasonable out-of-pocket costs associated with the foregoing within thirty (30) days of Optionee's receipt of an itemized statement of such costs together with all supporting documentation. If Optionee terminates this Lease Agreement pursuant to this Paragraph 4, any rent paid in advance shall be refunded to Optionee within thirty (30) days of Optionee's written demand.

5. The Optionor(s) shall be responsible for the payment of all real estate taxes which shall be assessed against the Property during the term of the lease. The Optionee shall pay all charges for heat, water, gas, electricity, sewer use charges and any other utility used or consumed by Optionee on the Property. The Optionee shall, at its own cost and expense, maintain and keep in full force and effect during the term of the lease public liability insurance with coverage in the amount of at least one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per person for bodily injury, disease, or death and shall maintain property insurance with Optioner as an additional insured on any property of the Optionee located on the Property.

* Except those mentioned in subparagraph 9.

6. The Optionee may assign the lease, but may not sublet all or any part of the space on the tower, or sublet all or any part of the Property without the express written consent of the Optionor(s)..

- 7. The Optionor(s) covenants that upon the Optionee's payment of the rent agreed upon herein, as well as Optionee's observing and performing all of the covenants and conditions contained in the lease, the Optionee may peacefully and quietly enjoy the Property subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the lease.
- 8. The Optionee agrees to maintain an access road in a passable manner for the term of the lease.
- 9. <u>Licensee's Payment of Taxes, Fees and Assessments</u>. Optionee shall pay directly to the applicable federal, state or local governmental unit or agency ("Governmental Entity") or to Optionor if Optionor is invoiced by such Governmental Entity, all taxes, fees, assessments or other charges assessed by any Governmental Entity directly against Optionee's Equipment and/or Optionee's use of the Facility. Optionee shall also pay to Optionor all taxes, fees, assessments or charges including, but not limited to, real and personal property taxes, attributable to Optionee's equipment and antenna(s), municipal franchise fees, use fees, municipal application fees, installation fees and increases thereof.
- 17. This Option and Lease Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties hereto and no modification or amendment shall be binding upon any party unless made in writing and signed by each of the parties hereto.
