
Re: Disqualification of Commissioner Caroline Pitt Clark

Dear Mrs. O'Donnell:

By Order dated October 4, 2007, Commissioner Clark is "voluntarily" refraining from participation in Case No. 2007-00143, a Kentucky-American Water Company rate case. Stating that the "public interest is best served" by so doing, Commissioner Clark advised all parties that she no is longer involved in that proceeding. However, no similar order has been entered in this case. Given the fact that the same grounds exist in this case, i.e., the involvement by Stoll Keenon Ogden PLLC, I inquire as to whether Commissioner Clark will enter an order wherein she will also refrain from participation in the instant matter.
